Late Fees and Interest on Overdue Accounts

Any Strathcona-Tweedsmuir School student account that has not been paid promptly, or in accordance with the fee schedule, and has not made acceptable payment arrangements with the Finance Department, may not be permitted to re-enroll at the school for the subsequent year. Parents/Guardians will continue to be liable for the full payment of the annual interest. **A rate of 2% per month or 24% per annum will be charged on the unpaid balance of the account after 30 days. All accounts over 120 days past due will be sent to a collections agency.**

Credit Card Transactions: All credit card transactions will be subject to a Credit Card Convenience Fee of 2.4%.
