



## Alumni Community Citizenship Award Terms of Reference

### Terms--Overview

The Alumni Community Citizenship Award is given annually to a member/s of the Strathcona-Tweedsmuir School Alumni Community, in recognition of substantial volunteer contributions or special service, over a period of time. It recognizes those that go above and beyond the call of duty to significantly improve Strathcona-Tweedsmuir School, the Community, and/or the STS Alumni Association.

### Award Recipient Criteria:

All STS Alumni community members are eligible. The Alumni Association committee members will consider both the length and nature of the volunteer service, including the diversity of roles undertaken, and consistency of service to the School.

### Eligibility (in all of the criteria)

- Consistent volunteerism for a significant period of time.
- Recipient(s) should be an alumni, alumni parent, and alumni employee of Strathcona-Tweedsmuir School or one of its founding schools.
- Alumni Community members is defined as: alumni (students that have attended STS), alumni parents (STS parents that no longer have children at STS), and alumni employees (employees that have since retired or moved on from STS).
- This recognition may be bestowed posthumously.

### Submission

- Submissions shall be made to the “Alumni Community Citizenship Award” Committee for consideration.
- Nominations are welcome by March 31 of each year.

### Selection

- The Committee will meet once a year or as needed to review list of proposed candidates and recommend a list of final candidates to be profiled within the school and to the external community.
- Final nominees will be profiled on the school website and on a plaque displayed with in the School.
- The Committee reserves the right to divest itself from a profiled recipient if it has deemed that his/her action has tarnished the criteria by which they were chosen to receive the recognition.
- If, in the opinion of the Awards Committee, no nominee merits recommendation for the award in any given year, it is not compelled to make a recommendation.
