

Terms--Overview

The Strathcona-Tweedsmuir School Alumni Association wishes to recognize alumni who have demonstrated the following notable accomplishments: significant leadership, professional achievement, service to community, well-rounded life and dedication to country. This distinction will be reflective of Strathcona-Tweedsmuir School's mission of developing well-balanced students for a life of purpose demonstrating core values of integrity, kindness, respect, responsibility, safety, and service.

Eligibility (in all of the criteria)

- Living the mission of STS—the recipient will be living a life of purpose, excelling in scholarship, leadership and character as well as implementing the learned skills of the STS co-curricular programs throughout his or her endeavors.
- Professional achievement and/or Career Distinction
- Service to Society--the recipient exhibits integrity and demonstrated commitment to service in bettering the lives of others through volunteer efforts.
- The recipient(s) should be an alumnus or alumna of Strathcona-Tweedsmuir School or one of its founding schools.
- Alumni are those who have attended STS for a minimum of one year.
- This recognition may be bestowed posthumously.

Submission

- Submissions shall be made to the "Nil Nisi Optimum" Committee for consideration.
- Nominations are welcome by March 31 of each year.

Selection

- The Committee up of the will meet once a year and as needed to review list of proposed candidates and recommend a list of final candidates to be profiled within the school and external community, through communications and on the website for a fixed period of time.
- Final nominees will be profiled by having their picture and a short description of their accomplishments on display within the school community.
- The Committee reserves the right to divest itself from a profiled alumna or alumnus if it has deemed that his/her action has tarnished the criteria by which they were chosen to receive the recognition.
- If, in the opinion of the Awards Committee, no nominee merits recommendation for the award in any given year, it is not compelled to make a recommendation.
